POINTS OF INTEREST

Points of interest are indicated by number on the map on the opposite side of this page.

- 1 NYC Councilwoman Margaret Chin**
165 Park Row, Suite 11 – NYC Council Member Margaret Chin is the local representative for District 1, Lower Manhattan. Council Member Chin provides District 1 constituents access to local government and nonprofit resources to address a variety of issues. The office is located at Chatham Green, a residential complex around the corner from Pearl St. and Madison St. Get more information at www.MargaretChin.nyc.org or call (212) 587-3159.
- 2 70 Mulberry Street**
The former Public School 23 building is a Norman Romanesque Revival edifice designed by C.B.J. Snyder in 1892.
- 3 Ancient Order of Hibernians** *32 James St*
The AOH is an Irish Catholic fraternal organization founded in 1836 at St. James Church.
- 4 Bowery Bank of New York Building** *124–128 Bowery* – Completed in 1902, its design was influenced by the City Beautiful movement and the Beaux-Arts style.
- 5 Brooklyn Bridge**
The first steel-wire suspension bridge, the 1,600 foot span has long been an NYC icon and a favorite for sightseers.
- 6 Chatham Square Library** *33 E Broadway*
Chatham Square Library has been an integral part of the Chinatown neighborhood since its earliest days.
- 7 Chinatown Partnership**
Chinatown Partnership is a resource for information about Chinatown.
- 8 Chinatown Fair Family Fun Center** *8 Mott St* – This colorful, hopping indoor arcade houses a selection of video games & other amusements.
- 9 Chinatown Ice Cream Factory** *65 Bayard St*
Serves ice cream with a Chinese twist, in flavors such as almond cookie, lychee, and taro, as well as traditional flavors.
- 10 Chinese Consolidated Benevolent Association & Chinese School** *62 Mott St* – The CCBA has served the needs of Chinese Americans since 1883. There are CCBA agencies in 26 cities across North America.
- 11 Church of the Most Precious Blood** *109 Mulberry St* – Built in the 1800s as an Italian National Parish, it also houses the National Shrine to San Gennaro.
- 12 Church of Transfiguration & Transfiguration School** *29 Mott St* – Built in 1801 for the Zion English Lutheran Church. The Transfiguration School is a Catholic parochial school open to children of all faiths.
- 13 Citizens Saving Bank (now HSBC)** *58 Bowery* – This monumental Beaux-Arts style building was designed by Clarence W. Brazer and completed in 1924.
- 14 Collect Pond Park** *Cobblehill Place*
The 18th century site of the NYC's main water supply and later “the Tombs” prison is now a green space with a pond.
- 15 Confucius Statue** *Confucius Plaza*
Sculpted by Liu Shih for the Chinese Consolidated Benevolent Association to celebrate the U.S. bicentennial, its base displays a Confucian proverb next to an American Flag.
- 16 East Broadway Mall** *88 E Broadway*
Located under the Manhattan Bridge, this popular mall holds many wedding-oriented services and a restaurant on the upper level.
- 17 Edward Mooney House** *18 Bowery*
The brick house, built 1789, is the City's oldest remaining townhouse in the Early Federal style.
- 18 Elizabeth Center Mall** *13 Elizabeth St*
If you want to shop for cute Asian accessories, dolls, or sticker pictures, Elizabeth Center Mall is the place for you.
- 19 First Shearith Israel Cemetery** *55–57 St James Pl* – Also known as Chatham Square Cemetery, the tiny graveyard was used in the seventeenth century.
- 20 Five Points**
Depicted in the film, *The Gangs of New York*, the neighborhood has been transformed by generations of industrious residents.
- 21 Funeral Services**
Mulberry St (Bayard–Worth St)
Several establishments between Bayard and Worth Streets provide services and ceremonial objects for the Chinese community.
- 22 Sara D. Roosevelt Park, Hester Playground** *Hester & Forsyth St* – Named for President Franklin Roosevelt's mother, the park stretches three city blocks and contains several playing fields.
- 23 Hon. Thomas Tam Way** *Cortlandt Alley*
Dr. Tam was the first Asian-American member of the City University of New York Board of Trustees and a founding member of the Chinatown Health Clinic.
- 24 Italian American Museum** *155 Mulberry St*
The museum documents the myriad contributions people of Italian descent have made to America.
- 25 Jing Fong Restaurant** *20 Elizabeth St*
The 800-seat capacity restaurant features a bustling atmosphere embodying all the essential elements of “yum cha,” a traditional dim sum brunch.
- 26 Kimlau Arch & Lin Zexu Statue** *Chatham Square* – The Kimlau Memorial Arch was erected in 1961 to honor service members of Chinese ancestry who died serving their country. Next to the arch is a bronze statue of Lin Zexu, an official of the Qing dynasty who fought to ban opium.
- 27 Manhattan Bridge** *Canal & Bowery*
Opened in 1909 and designed by Leon Moisseiff, the bridge is 1,470 ft long with a walkway and bikeway.
- 28 Mahayana Buddhist Temple** *133 Canal St*
New York City's largest Buddhist temple contains a 16-foot-tall gold statue or the Buddha, prints pictures depicting the life of the Buddha, and provides spaces for families to pay tribute to deceased relatives.
- 29 Mariners' Temple Baptist Church** *3 Henry St*
Originally known as the Oliver Street Baptist Church, the Church was established in 1795.
- 30 Marriage Bureau** *141 Worth St*
Provides Marriage Licenses, Domestic Partnership registration, civil Marriage Ceremonies, and registration of Marriage Officials.
- 31 Museum at Eldridge Street** *12 Eldridge St*
The 1887 building is one of the city's most breathtaking National Historic Landmarks. The museum offers an intimate and authentic portal to the past for people of all backgrounds.
- 32 Museum of Chinese in America** *215 Centre St*
Founded in 1980, MoCA is dedicated to preserving and presenting the history, heritage, culture and diverse experiences of people of Chinese descent in the United States.
- 33 The New Museum** *235 Bowery*
The New Museum is a home for contemporary art and an incubator for new ideas. The museum serves a diverse and expanding international audience, including artists, students, and residents.
- 34 Nom Wah Tea Parlor** *13 Doyers St*
Since 1920, Nom Wah has been a neighborhood staple offering fresh Chinese pastries, steamed buns, dim sum and tea. It is famous for its homemade lotus paste and red bean filled moon cakes baked during the Chinese autumn festival.
- 35 Pearl River Mart** *477 Broadway*
An eclectic emporium with 3 floors of Chinese apparel, accessories, housewares & furniture.
- 36 Pvt. Danny Chen Way** *Elizabeth @ Canal St*
Raised on Elizabeth Street, Pvt. Chen was a Chinese-American soldier who took his own life after being racially bullied by fellow officers. His passing inspired calls for a thorough review of hazing and harassment policies within the U.S. military.
- 37 Coleman Square Playground** *Market & Monroe St*
Named in honor of Corporal Joseph F. Coleman, a resident of Madison Street who fought in WWI as a member of the American Expeditionary Force (AEF).
- 38 St. Patrick's Old Cathedral Basilica** *263 Mulberry St* – The first “St. Patrick's Cathedral” was built in the neo-gothic style between 1809–1815. The Basilica has the largest catacombs in the City located beneath the church.
- 39 Dr. Sun Yat Sen Statue** *Columbus Park*
The bronze statue of Dr. Sun Yat Sen, the first president of the Republic of China, was designed by Taiwanese sculptor Lu Chun-Hsiung and erected in Columbus Park in 2011.
- 40 Ting's Gift Shop** *18 Doyers St*
In business since 1957, Ting's sells novelty goods and accessories.
- 41 Wedding Garden** *Foley Square*
Conveniently located just outside the Marriage Bureau, it's a great place to snap photos to commemorate “tying the knot.”
- 42 Zhe “Zack” Zeng Way** *Bayard & Mulberry St*
Zhe “Zack” Zeng was a first-generation immigrant who perished heroically on September 11, 2011 while assisting firefighters rescuing injured individuals.

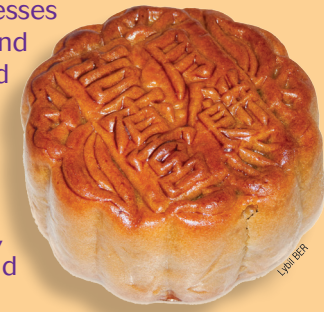
